SUBJECT: MUR 7922 (Bryan Williams)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

23

On July 29, 2021, the Commission found reason to believe that Bryan Williams knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)(3), 30102(c), 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9, 102.15, and 104.3 by failing to keep complete records and file accurate reports with the Commission and by commingling committee funds, of the Kern County Republican Central Committee (the "Committee"), and personal funds. The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with Respondent. Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement signed by Respondent and a redlined version as compared to the opening offer approved by the Commission. We recommend that the Commission accept the signed agreement and close the file in this matter.
