

CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING

Respondent, Hunter Davis Pace, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7932 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a). The period of tolling shall begin on December 21, 2023, and continue until the date of conclusion of the criminal case captioned State of Mississippi v. Hunter Davis Pace, Case No. LK20-020, which is pending in the Circuit Court of Lafayette County, Mississippi.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for the above-described period, from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to instate a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
