On October 13, 2021, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(b)(3) and 30104(b) of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), and 11 C.F.R. § 102.15, 104.3, and 104.14(d) of the Commission's regulations. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on February 10, 2025, to take no further action, and voted to close the file in this matter effective March 12, 2025. Any applicable Statements of Reasons available at the time of this letter's transmittal are enclosed.
