Dear Mr. Johnson:

On November 3, 2021, the Federal Election Commission notified that you and The Octavian Group, LLC, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On July 13, 2023, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d) by using State Committee funds to pay for federal testing-the-waters expenses with respect to the disbursements identified in the complaint other than those to the Octavian Group, LLC. The Commission also exercised its prosecutorial discretion and dismissed the allegations that you and the Octavian Group, LLC, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d) by using state committee funds to pay for federal testing-the-waters expenses with respect to the disbursements to the Octavian Group, LLC. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
