To whom it may concern:

The following is a complaint of potential violation(s) of FEC regulations committed by **Kimberly N. Klacik**, aka **Red Renaissance (C00763797)** and/or **KIM KLACIK FOR CONGRESS (C00726117)**.

Per a Twitter post on September 11, 2021, Klacik claimed to travel with her daughter:



In a variety of other social media posts (e.g., Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram) by Klacik, she has revealed her daughter, Olivia, is now about five- to six-years old. Numerous posts by Klacik have shown Olivia in locales that are not in Maryland where Klacik and her daughter make their residence (Middle River). For example, vegetation that is not found in Maryland, such as palm trees is shown in these posts. Klacik has also posted about making business trips related to her congressional run and Red Renaissance to Florida, where palm trees are plentiful.

In recent filings for Red Renaissance and possibly earlier for KIM KLACIK FOR CONGRESS, Klacik has not shown what portion of the travel and other expenses (dining, security, etc.) are attributable to Olivia. Given the child's age, it is most likely she is staying in-room and dining with Klacik. More clarity is needed in her FEC filings in this regard.

Additionally, from her congressional campaign funds, Klacik made a \$15,000 charitable contribution to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel School, which is her daughter's private school in Essex, Md. Surely, there are laws against making contributions that can be so personally beneficial.
