Re: MUR 7948 (Grassroots Victory PAC) – Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation

I. INTRODUCTION

On December 16, 2021, the Commission voted to open a MUR and found reason to believe that Grassroots Victory PAC and John Skic in his official capacity as treasurer ("GVP" or the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) by failing to accurately report disbursements. The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in preprobable cause conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement. Attached is a signed negotiated agreement which would resolve the matter. Also attached is a redlined version as compared to the opening offer approved by the Commission. We recommend that the Commission accept the attached negotiated agreement and close the file.
