21 Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation Agreement

22 On December 16, 2021, the Commission found reason to believe that Crown Products
23 and Services, Inc. and Steven Douglas Simmons violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30118(a) and 30122, and
24 11 C.F.R. §§ 114.2(b) and 110.4(b)(1)(i) by making and consenting to \$13,500 in corporate
25 contributions made in the name of another. The Commission also authorized pre-probable cause
26 conciliation (“PPCC”)

27 Respondents have submitted a signed agreement with no changes from the agreement
28 previously approved by the Commission. *See Attachment.* We recommend that the Commission
29 accept the signed agreement and close the file in this matter.
