I write to submit a formal complaint against Steven Cody Reynolds, Democratic candidate for Congress in Oregon's 6th District, and the "Cody for Oregon" campaign committee.

The candidate and associated entity have begun aggressive advertising campaigns ahead of the May 17, 2022 primary election. There are at least two television advertisements currently running in Oregon with missing or sufficient on-screen disclaimers and spoken approval, elements which are clearly required under federal law and FEC regulations. These advertisements are also available on the Internet and may be part of the Reynolds' campaigns Internet advertising efforts as well.
