 26 On February 15, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Just the Truth
 27 Political Action Committee and Jodi Schwartz in her official capacity as treasurer (“Committee”)
 28 violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(2) and approved pre-probable cause conciliation with the
 29 Committee.¹ The Committee failed to timely file 48-hour notices of independent expenditures
 30 totaling \$455,309.94 on its 2020 October Quarterly Report and independent expenditures
 31 totaling \$76,858.83 on its 2020 12-Day Pre-General Report.
