Dear Ms. Stevenson and Mr. Kitcher:

We are writing regarding an administrative complaint that Campaign Legal Center (CLC) submitted to the Commission on February 28, 2022, regarding alleged violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act by Iho Araise LLC (“Iho Araise”). The matter was numbered matter under review (“MUR”) 7965.

CLC recently identified that Saving Arizona PAC, the independent-expenditure only committee that disclosed the \$50,000 contribution from Iho Araise that is the subject of CLC’s February 28 complaint, filed an amended 2021 Year-End disclosure report on February 7, 2022, reattributing Iho Araise’s contribution to Arjun Sethi and Harshita Pant.

CLC was not aware of the amended 2021 Year-End disclosure report when we filed the complaint in this matter, and had we been aware of the amended report identifying the true sources of Iho Araise’s contribution to Saving Arizona PAC, we would not have filed the complaint.

Accordingly, we request that the Commission treat the Complaint in MUR 7965 as withdrawn.
