SUBJECT: MUR 7971 (Indiana Democratic Congressional Victory Committee, *et al.*)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On March 22, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that the Indiana Democratic Congressional Victory Committee and Henry Fernandez¹ in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign of 1971, as amended (the “Act”), by failing to timely and accurately disclose disbursements.² The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee and approved a conciliation agreement.³ We recommend that the Commission accept the attached, signed conciliation agreement and close the file in this matter.
