SUBJECT: MUR 7972 (ProgressNow AZ – Federal)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On March 22, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that ProgressNow AZ – Federal and Darryl Tattre in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(b)(2) by failing to file or timely file 48-Hour Reports, and that the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d) by failing to accurately report debt.¹ The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.²
