 24 On March 22, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Burgess 4 Utah and  
 25 Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer (“the Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f)  
 26 by accepting and failing to take timely corrective action as to \$92,604.26 in excessive  
 27 contributions.<sup>1</sup> The Commission also authorized pre-probable cause conciliation (“PPCC”) and  
 28 approved a conciliation agreement.
