Skaggs, Joseph R. Skaggs, and Terryl Jay Skaggs violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by making, allowing one's name to be used, or knowingly accepting a contribution in the name of another; (2) find reason to believe that Teeter Jay, LLC, violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(g)(5) by failing to provide required attribution information; (3) find reason to believe that The Freedom Forward Fund and Mike McCauley in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(e) by failing to report attribution information; and (4) direct the Office of General Counsel to draft Factual and Legal Analyses and Conciliation
