A quarterly report for the time period ending on March 31, 2022 was not filed with the FEC because my campaign did not cross the \$5,000 threshold for contributions received or expenditures made.

I consulted with my assigned FEC Analyst who confirmed the threshold reporting requirement is triggered at \$5,000 and report filing is not required until that point.

I submitted FEC Form 99, Miscellaneous Document, stating the \$5,000 threshold was not met, therefore the report filing was not required.

As a retired federal law enforcement officer, who spent 33 years enforcing federal laws, I fully intend to adhere to the reporting requirements, when the threshold is met, during the appropriate reporting period.

I believe that Evan Albertson is the current campaign manager for incumbent Congressman Tony Gonzales, who is my opponent.

[1] Generally, an individual becomes a candidate for federal office (and thus triggers registration and reporting obligations) when his or her campaign exceeds \$5,000 in either contributions received or expenditures made. If the campaign has not crossed the \$5,000 threshold, it is not required to file reports.
