To Whom It May Concern:

When researching U.S. Senate candidates for Idaho, I discovered that Benjamin (Ben) Pursley has not filed as a candidate as required by law. He has loaned himself money as of March 31, 2022, making him a candidate, but his candidacy form has not been filed. Additionally, he filed in Idaho as a candidate, but has yet to file at the federal level.

His committee has filed a report, but it does not appear that he has filed FEC Form 2, Statement of Candidacy. I am concerned that, without it, he is in violation of federal law and will not be able to adequately serve if elected. As a concerned Democrat, I want our primary to be above-board and in compliance with federal election law.

I urge you to look into this matter as soon as possible.

Personal loans from the candidate

Candidates may loan their personal funds for campaign purposes. When they do so, they are making contributions to their campaigns. Unlike other contributions, these candidate contributions are not subject to any limits but are subject to additional reporting. Moreover, timing restrictions apply to the repayment of personal loans aggregating more than \$250,000 for an election.

HOW TO REPORT

Registering a candidate

An individual running for the House, Senate or President becomes a candidate when they raises or spends more than \$5,000 in contributions or expenditures. Candidates must register using a Statement of Candidacy (Form 2) within 15 days after becoming a candidate. A candidate, including an incumbent, must file a Statement of Candidacy for each election cycle in which they are a candidate.

Reporting on candidate forms

All federal candidates register using the Statement of Candidacy, Form 2.

On Line 1, enter the name and mailing address of the candidate.

On Line 2, enter the candidate's identification number. Candidates should leave this field blank if they:

- Have never run before
