Thank you for your response to the Amendment in MUR 7990 on November 28, 2022, which the Office of General Counsel will be incorporating in our report to the Commission. After further consideration of the allegations in the Amendment to the Complaint that was provided to you on November 8, 2022, we have determined that the allegations that the Committee accepted a loan from your firm require us to generate your law firm as a respondent.
