On February 27, 2024, the Commission voted to find reason to believe that Make America Great Again, Again! Inc. and Charles Gantt in his official capacity as treasurer ("MAGA Again!") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(e) by failing to report attribution information.¹ The Commission authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with MAGA Again! and directed the Office of General Counsel to draft a conciliation agreement.² On January 14, 2025, the Commission approved a conciliation agreement.³
