
I am writing with a complaint regarding campaign finance violations by Patricia R Dowell, candidate for Congress in IL-01, and associated committee, Pat Dowell for Congress (C00799650). Below please find the outline of what I believe to be violations of campaign finance law.

Summary

Alderwoman Pat Dowell, a federal candidate for Congress, suspended her race for Secretary of State and announced she would run for Congress on January 5, 2022, but continued to use her nonfederal account to fund routine campaign expenses through March 31, 2022, as reported on her Illinois campaign finance disclosure on April 15, 2022, which appears to violate the law.

Facts

 Alderwoman Pat Dowell <u>announced</u> her campaign for Illinois Secretary of State on April 7, 2021, and <u>amended</u> her nonfederal committee with the State of Illinois for reporting contributions and expenditures for this race on December 02, 2021.



 On January 5, 2022, Dowell <u>announced</u> that she was suspending her campaign for Secretary of State, and launching a campaign for Congress in Illinois' First District. She <u>organized</u> a federal committee for reporting contributions and expenditures in that race on January 6, 2022.

Dowell's nonfederal political committee continued to pay for routine campaigning expenses
well into her Congressional campaign, as late as March 31, 2022, the last day which the
April 2022 Quarterly report covers, according to her disclosures.

While some of these (i.e. consulting fees) could be reasonably explained as outstanding expenses from her Secretary of State's race, others are inarguably not: food, rent, gas, hall rental, cleaning, vote builder, utilities, printing, postage, Ubers (ride-share service), advertising, salaries, office supplies, and other expenses were all purchased well after she suspended her campaign and launched a federal campaign.

In total, Dowell spent \$169,024.06 on campaign expenses from her nonfederal account Citizens for Dowell AFTER she announced she was no longer running for a non-federal race and she was running for Congress. They are as follows.

4. Dowell's federal political committee's April 2022 Quarterly report shows few or no similar expenses, continuing to reinforce the fact that these expenses were used for her Congressional campaign. For example, there are no reported expenses for postage, transportation, voter file, NGP-VAN, G-suite, rent, printing, utilities, telephones, and office supplies during the same period in which she reports them on the nonfederal report.

Law

According to the Federal Election Commission, a candidate's authorized (federal) committee may not accept funds or assets transferred from a committee established by the same candidate for a nonfederal election campaign. At its option, however, a nonfederal committee of the same candidate may refund its leftover funds to its contributors and may coordinate arrangements with the federal campaign for a solicitation of those same persons. The full cost of this solicitation must be paid by the federal committee.

Further, federal law limits contributions from any given individual to \$2,900 per election, while Illinois law permits contributions from any individual to \$5,000 per Election. Illinois nonfederal committees are also permitted to accept contributions from corporations, whereas federal committees are not, so even if Dowell was able to use nonfederal money, such contributions would be not permissible and violate federal law. Conclusion

There is reason to believe that Pat Dowell's Congressional campaign has benefitted from expenditures made by the nonfederal committee Citizens for Pat Dowell. Under those circumstances, Dowell appears to have violated campaign law by 1. Accepting "funds and assets" from a nonfederal campaign to a federal campaign and 2. Using nonfederal funds in excess of federal limits and nonqualified donors for a federal race. We request the Commission begin an immediate investigation, and if violation(s) are found, that Dowell be held accountable.
