Dear Mr. Kistner:

On January 11 and June 8, 2022, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified you of two complaints alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). Copies of the complaints were provided at those times.

On January 24, 2023, the Commission considered the allegations contained in the complaints and materials submitted by the Committee, but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe or no reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g) by converting campaign funds to personal use. Accordingly, on January 24, 2023, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision will follow.
