On September 18, 2023, Stephen Houlahan for Santee Mayor 2020 was notified the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). At that time, you were given a copy of the complaint and information that a response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.

On October 19, 2023, the Commission received additional information from the complainant pertaining to the allegations in the complaint. The supplement was not sent to you earlier due to administrative oversight. Enclosed is a copy of this additional information. If you wish to consider this information in your response to the allegations, you are hereby afforded an additional 15 days to do so, or we will assume the previous response is also intended for this correspondence.
