On June 8, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Alabama Conservatives Fund PAC and Kaylen Melton in her official capacity as treasurer (“Committee”), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On April 13, 2023, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint and information provided by you, on behalf of your client, that there is no reason to believe that the Committee 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(c). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
