Dear Mr. Spies:

On June 14, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Gun Owners Action Fund, of a complaint alleging that Gun Owners Action Fund had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On December 15, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe Gun Owners Action Fund violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(c). Accordingly, on February 1, 2023, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
