**SUBJECT:** MUR 8012 (Black Voters Matter Action PAC)  
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

---

On June 7, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Black Voters Matter Action PAC and Kamau Franklin in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(c) by failing to timely report independent expenditures aggregating \$1,000 or more made after the 20th day, but more than 24 hours before an election.<sup>1</sup> The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.<sup>2</sup>
