**SUBJECT:** MUR 8012 (Black Voters Matter Action PAC)

Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On June 7, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Black Voters Matter Action PAC and Kamau Franklin in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(c) by failing to timely report independent expenditures aggregating \$1,000 or more made after the 20th day, but more than 24 hours before an election. The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in preprobable cause conciliation with the Committee.<sup>2</sup>
