Dear Ms. Robinson:

On November 24, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Kristine Schanbacher for Congress and its treasurer (the "Committee") that the Commission, in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, had ascertained information indicating that the Committee may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On June 7, 2022, after considering all the information, the Commission determined to exercise its prosecutorial discretion to dismiss this matter. *See Hecker v. Chaney*, 470 U.S. 821 (1985). Accordingly, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
