Re: MUR 8020 on behalf of Pat Ryan for Congress; and Wyatt Brown, Treasurer

Dear Mr. Campbell:

I am writing on behalf of Pat Ryan for Congress, and Wyatt Brown, in his official capacity as Treasurer (collectively, "Respondents") in response to a complaint filed with the Federal Election Commission's ("FEC," or the "Commission") by William Gunnar Truitt.

For the reasons stated below, Mr. Truitt's complaint has no merit whatsoever and should be dismissed.

The factual background relative to this matter is properly summarized in the complaint and does not require recapitulation here. In summary, Pat Ryan is simultaneously a candidate for federal office in two districts. One, a special election and the other a regularly held primary election. This anomaly was caused by the resignation of a member of Congress as well as the shifting of district lines in accordance with 2022 congressional redistricting. A copy of Respondent's Form 1, which fully discloses Mr. Ryan's campaigns and districts is attached to this response.<sup>1</sup>

However, the complaint falsely and incorrectly alleges that Pat Ryan for Congress was required to establish separate campaign committees for each election. The Commission has consistently held that a candidate for multiple elections may use one campaign committee in connection with these multiple elections, as long as those elections are for the same Federal office.<sup>2</sup>

For example, in Advisory Opinion 1980-80, a candidate was running in a primary and a special election, and the Commission confirmed that candidates only need separate committees

when running for separate offices.<sup>3</sup> Additionally, in Advisory Opinion 1984-42, the Commission confirmed that a candidate "seeking election to two separate terms of the same office does not require the establishment to two separate principal campaign committees. The establishment of two separate committees is only required when a candidate is seeking election to more than one 'office."

With respect to Mr. Ryan's campaign activities, Mr. Ryan is not required to separate his campaigning for the two districts. Mr. Ryan may advocate for his election for each district in any way he chooses whether it be by separate or combined communications. In Advisory Opinion 1986-31, the Commission instructed a committee that had multiple elections on the same date that it "may treat undesignated contributions which are otherwise lawful as made with respect to either election or both elections. The committee may allocate a portion of an undesignated contribution to the regular election and another portion to the special election as long as such allocation does not result in the contributor's exceeding his or her (or its) aggregate contribution limitations for both elections. Furthermore, the Commission advised that "contributions legally made and accepted with respect to these two elections may be expended for either election or both elections."

Finally, a committee is not required to specifically notify a donor as to which election a contribution is being allocated to as long as the aggregate contribution limits for each election are not exceeded.<sup>8</sup>

The issues raised in this matter are not cases of first impression and the Commission has consistently allowed candidates who have two elections for the same office on the same date to comport themselves in the exact manner that Pat Ryan for Congress has chosen to structure its activities. To be sure, the campaign specifically sought and received guidance from the Commission prior to filing its paperwork to ensure that its activities were in full compliance with the Act.<sup>9</sup>

Based upon the above, the complaint in this matter has no merit and the Commission should find that there is no reason to believe that Respondents violated the Act and immediately dismiss this complaint.
