CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on March 30, 2023, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Patrick Ryan violated 52 U.S.C. §30102(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 101.1(a), 102.12(a) by failing to file a Statement of Candidacy as to the 19th District.
 - b. Find no reason to believe that Patrick Ryan violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.8(d)(1) by failing to designate separate committees to solicit funds for his two campaigns.
 - c. Find no reason to believe that Pat Ryan for Congress and Wyatt Brown in his official capacity violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.8(d)(1) by concurrently soliciting contributions for two different campaigns.
 - d. Approve Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 9, 2023.
 - e. Authorize pre-probable cause conciliation with Patrick Ryan.
 - f. Approve the proposed Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 9, 2023.
 - g. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

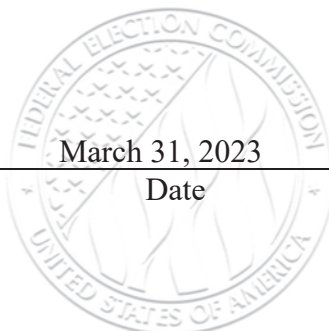
Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented. Commissioner Lindenbaum was recused and did not vote.

2. Decided by a vote of 5-0 to:

- a. Dismiss with admonishment allegations that Patrick Ryan violated 52 U.S.C. §30102(e)(1) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 101.1(a), 102.12(a) by failing to file a Statement of Candidacy as to New York's 19th Congressional District.
- b. Find no reason to believe that Patrick Ryan violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.8(d)(1) by failing to designate separate committees to solicit funds for his two campaigns.
- c. Find no reason to believe that Pat Ryan for Congress and Wyatt Brown in his official capacity violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.8(d)(1) by concurrently soliciting contributions for two different campaigns.
- d. Approve the proposed Factual and Legal Analyses, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 9, 2023, subject to the edits discussed at the table.
- e. Close the file.
- f. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioner Lindenbaum was recused and did not vote.
