SUBJECT: MUR 8022 (MEI Services, Inc.)

RE: Circulation of Discovery Documents

As part of the investigation in the above-referenced matter, we are circulating the attached subpoena directed to Respondent MEI Services, Inc. for the Commission's approval on a 48-hour no-objection basis.

On February 9, 2023, the Commission found reason to believe that MEI Services, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a) and 11 U.S.C. § 115.2(a) by making prohibited federal contractor contributions.¹ In addition, the Commission instructed the Office of General Counsel to prepare a subpoena with a document request in order to determine whether MEI Services, Inc. had received a refund of the prohibited federal contractor contributions totaling \$139,500.

Accordingly, we request that the Commission approve on a 48-hour no-objection basis the attached document subpoena to MEI Services, Inc.
