**MURs 8017 and 8023**

- i. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis for Christian Printer, Inc., as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated June 16, 2023.
- j. Authorize compulsory process.
- k. Approve the appropriate letters.

2. Decided by a vote of 4-2 to:

Dismiss the complaints.
