23 Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

26 On July 14, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Dan Crenshaw for

27 Congress and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated

28 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(f) and 30118(a) by knowingly accepting excessive and prohibited corporate

29 contributions in the aggregate amount of \$223,460.26.¹ The Commission also authorized pre-

30 probable cause to believe conciliation and approved a conciliation agreement

9 Committee. Finally, we recommend that the Commission close the file in this matter.
