1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Open a MUR.
 - b. Find reason to believe that the Hawaii Republican Party and Stephen C. Holck in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(2), (4) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.3(a), (b); 102.17(c).
 - c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 14, 2021.
 - d. Authorize pre-probable cause conciliation with the Hawaii Republican Party and Stephen C. Holck in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - e. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 14, 2021.
 - f. Approve the appropriate letter.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioner Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Reject the Office of General Counsel's recommendations, and instead refer the matter to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Office.

Commissioners Cooksey, Trainor, and Walther voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Dickerson, and Weintraub dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 4-2 to:

- b. Find reason to believe that the Hawaii Republican Party and Stephen C. Holck in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(2), (4) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.3(a), (b); 102.17(c).
- c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 14, 2021.
- d. Authorize pre-probable cause conciliation with the Hawaii Republican Party and Stephen C. Holck in his official capacity as treasurer.
- e. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 14, 2021,
- f. Approve the appropriate letter.
