This is a new complaint against Jim Banks for Congress campaign committee. Based on the latest campaign finance documents I could find online, it appears that Jim Banks campaign committee received excessive contributions from a Tom Kelley.

It is my understanding Jim Banks for Congress received a \$2,500 contribution from a Tom Kelley from a conduit as the FEC filing states this donation as "earmarked (nondirected)". This is dated April 1, 2022. This contribution lists this Tom Kelley as chairman of Kelley Automotive and thus would appear to be the same Tom Kelley who gave in 2021 under Kelley Automotive even though the address listed is different and given that I am unaware of any change of status of Kelley Automotive from it being a sole proprietorship.

It is my understanding that a Tom Kelley made a \$10,000 contribution through Kelley Automotive, LLC to the Banks Victory Fund, a joint fundraising committee, on March 31, 2021, which allocated to Jim Banks for Congress \$2,900 for the 2022 primary election and \$2,900 for the 2022 general election, with the remainder going to Bank's Leadership PAC, House Conservatives Fund.

This \$2,500 donation by Tom Kelley for the 2022 primary on top of the \$2,900 donation by Tom Kelley treatment of earmarked contributions. While it appears this donation could have been redesignated have exceeded allowed amounts.



Contributions which on their face exceed the contribution limitations set forth in 11 CFR 110.1 or 110.2 or 110.2 or, and contributions which do not appear to be excessive on their face, but which exceed the contribution limits set forth in 11 CFR 110.1 or 110.2 when aggregated with other contributions from the same contributor, and contributions which cannot be accepted under the net debts outstanding provisions of 11 CFR 110.1(b)(3) or and 110.2(b)(3) or may be either deposited into a campaign depository under 11 CFR 103.3(a) or returned to the contributor. If any such contribution is deposited, the treasurer may request redesignation or reattribution of the contribution by the contributor in accordance with 11 CFR 110.1(b) or, 110.1(k) or or 110.2(b) or, as appropriate. If a redesignation or reattribution is not obtained, the treasurer shall, within sixty days of the treasurer's receipt of the contribution, refund the contribution to the contributor.
- **4.** Any contribution which appears to be illegal under 11 CFR 103.3(b) (1) or (3), and which is deposited into a campaign depository shall not be used for any disbursements by the political committee until the contribution has been determined to be legal. The political committee must either establish a separate account in a campaign depository for such contributions or maintain sufficient funds to make all such refunds.
- 5. If a contribution which appears to be illegal under 11 CFR 103.3(b) (1) or (3) is deposited in a campaign depository, the treasurer shall make and retain a written record noting the basis for the appearance of illegality. A statement noting that the legality of the contribution is in question shall be included in the report noting the receipt of the contribution. If a contribution is refunded to the contributor because it cannot be determined to be legal, the treasurer shall note the refund on the report covering the reporting period in which the refund is made.
