1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
  - a. Find reason to believe that Angel Staffing, Inc., made a prohibited government contractor contribution in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(a).
  - b. Take no action at this time as to Protect and Serve PAC and Charles Gantt in his official capacity as treasurer.
  - c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 8, 2023, subject to the edits circulated by Commissioner Weintraub's Office on April 27, 2023 at 5:27 p.m.
  - d. Authorize pre-probable cause conciliation with Angel Staffing, Inc.
  - e. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
  - a. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion allegations that Angel Staffing, Inc., made a prohibited government contractor contribution in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(a).
  - b. Dismiss allegations with respect to Protect and Serve PAC and Charles Gantt in his official capacity as treasurer.
  - c. Close the file.
  - d. Issue appropriate letters.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:
  - a. Close the file.
  - b. Issue appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, Trainor, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
