Dear Ms. Kato:

On August 8, 2023, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging that Annette Taddeo for Governor had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On December 12, 2023, the Commission considered the complaint, but there were insufficient votes to find reason to believe that Annette Taddeo for Governor violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d) by making an impermissible transfer of an asset to a federal committee. There were also insufficient votes to dismiss the allegations that Annette Taddeo for Governor violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d) by making an impermissible transfer of an asset to a federal committee. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decisions will follow.
