On August 4, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified Winfrey for Congress and you, as treasurer (the "Committee"), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to you and the candidate at that time.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the Committee, the Commission, on February 28, 2024, voted to dismiss this matter.
