1. Find no reason to believe that Charles Gray violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 or 11 C.F.R. § 110.4 by permitting his name to be used to effect contributions in the name of another or 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) or 11 C.F.R. § 110.9 by knowingly accepting excessive contributions.
2. Find no reason to believe that Citizens for Chuck Gray and Jean Kordenbrock in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 or 11 C.F.R. § 110.4 by knowingly accepting contributions made in the name of another or 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) or 11 C.F.R. § 110.9 by knowingly accepting excessive contributions.
3. Find no reason to believe that Jan Charles Gray violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 or 11 C.F.R. § 110.4 by making contributions in the name of another or 52 U.S.C. § 30116(a) or 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(b) by making excessive contributions.
4. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 21, 2023.
5. Approve the appropriate letters.
6. Close the file.
