20 **SUBJECT:** MUR 8049 (Workers Vote)
21 Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement
22

23 On August 9, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Workers Vote and
24 Zaina Tannu in her official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C.
25 § 30104(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d) by failing to accurately report its debt.¹ The
26 Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause
27 conciliation with the Committee and approved a conciliation agreement. We recommend that
28 the Commission accept the attached signed conciliation agreement and close the file in this
29 matter.

30 Attached is a revised conciliation agreement, signed by counsel for the Committee, that
31 would settle the violations in this matter.³
