**SUBJECT:** MUR 8049 (Workers Vote)  
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On August 9, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Workers Vote and Zaina Tannu in her official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d) by failing to accurately report its debt.<sup>1</sup> The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee and approved a conciliation agreement. We recommend that the Commission accept the attached signed conciliation agreement and close the file in this matter.

Attached is a revised conciliation agreement, signed by counsel for the Committee, that would settle the violations in this matter.<sup>3</sup>
