It appears that the complaint was received by the FEC on August 24, 2022, and Viking was notified on August 30, 2022. As this complaint involves allegations of potential violations, at least three respondents and potentially more (that I do not represent). As I was retained today, I have not been able to devote the requisite time to investigate and respond to this complaint. Based on the apparent complexity of the allegations and the scope of due diligence required to provide an appropriate response, I am requesting a thirty-day extension from today.
