Dear Mr. Winkelman and Ms. Kemp:

On September 8, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Andrew Garbarino, Garbarino for Congress and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer, and Friends of Andrew Garbarino, of a Complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the Complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time. The Commission considered the Complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that your clients violated the Act or Commission regulations. Accordingly, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter on August 10, 2023. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
