Skyler Massy 30102(d), 301 disbursement and failing to General Cour negotiated co he opening o	eptember 13, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that UtePAC and v in his official capacity as treasurer ("UtePAC") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(c), 102(h), and 30104(b) by misstating financial activity, understating total receipts an s, making cash disbursements, failing to maintain records to support disbursements correctly disclose disbursements. <sup>1</sup> The Commission authorized the Office of nsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with UtePAC. <sup>2</sup> Attached is a nciliation agreement signed by Respondent and a redlined version as compared to offer approved by the Commission. We recommend that the Commission accept th nent and close the file in this matter.
