SUBJECT: MUR 8067 (UtePAC)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On September 13, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that UtePAC and Skyler Massy in his official capacity as treasurer ("UtePAC") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(c), 30102(d), 30102(h), and 30104(b) by misstating financial activity, understating total receipts and disbursements, making cash disbursements, failing to maintain records to support disbursements and failing to correctly disclose disbursements. ${ }^{1}$ The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with UtePAC. ${ }^{2}$ Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement signed by Respondent and a redlined version as compared to the opening offer approved by the Commission. We recommend that the Commission accept the signed agreement and close the file in this matter.
