Dear Mr. Christopher,

On May 24, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified you that it, in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, had ascertained information indicating you may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). On February 22, 2023, after considering all the information, the Commission determined to dismiss the allegation that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b), a provision of the Act, and 11 C.F.R. § 113.21(g), a provision of the Commission’s regulations, by converting campaign funds to personal use. Accordingly, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
