15	On M	arch 20, 2023, the Office of General Counsel recommended that the Commission

On March 20, 2023, the Office of General Counsel recommended that the Commission take no action at this time as to Stop Socialism in OC and David Satterfield in his official capacity as treasurer ("Stop Socialism in OC") as to possible violations of 52 U.S.C § 30119(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(c) in connection with the solicitation of a contribution from a federal government contractor. On April 18, 2023, the Commission instead found no reason to believe that Stop Socialism in OC violated 52 U.S.C § 30119(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(c) and instructed the Office of General Counsel to draft a commensurate Factual and Legal Analysis.²
