11 **SUBJECT:** MUR 8073 (Vista Pacifica Enterprises, Inc., *et al.*) – Pre-Probable Cause  
12 Conciliation Agreement  
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15 On April 18, 2023, the Commission found reason to believe that Vista Pacifica  
16 Enterprises, Inc., (“Vista Pacifica”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(a) by  
17 making a prohibited federal contractor contribution to Stop Socialism in OC and David  
18 Satterfield in his official capacity as treasurer (“Stop Socialism in OC”) and authorized pre-  
19 probable cause conciliation .<sup>1</sup>

The Commission also found no reason to believe as to Stop Socialism in OC, and closed the file as to Stop Socialism in OC on May 4, 2023, when it approved the Factual and Legal Analysis. recommend that the Commission accept this agreement and close the file in this matter.

1. Accept the attached Conciliation Agreement with Vista Pacifica Enterprises, Inc.;
2. Approve the appropriate letters; and
3. Close the file.
