SUBJECT: MUR 8074 (Kim Klacik for Congress)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On September 28, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Kim Klacik for Congress and Bradley Crate in his official capacity as treasurer (the “Committee”) violated: (1) 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 103.3(b) and 110.9 by knowingly accepting excessive contributions; (2) 52 U.S.C. § 30102(e)(3)(B) by making an excessive contribution; (3) 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 103.3(b) and 110.9 by knowingly accepting prohibited corporate contributions; and (4) 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 103.3(b) by knowingly accepting a prohibited contribution from an unregistered organization.¹ The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.²
