Dear Mr. Bookbinder:

The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated October 27, 2024, but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe Unknown Respondents; Florida Promise, Inc.; The Center for Advancement of Integrity and Justice; Grow United, Inc.; Broken Promises; or Stand Up for Justice violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, or to dismiss the complaint. Accordingly, on February 27, 2024, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
