On November 3, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified your client South Florida Residents First and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer (“the Committee”) of a complaint alleging that the Committee may have violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”).
