Blumberg PB by BY: 12 Assistant General Counsel 13 Dominique Dillenseger DD14 Attorney 15 SUBJECT: MUR 8094 (Brady PAC) 16 Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement 17 18 On December 13, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Brady PAC and 19 Jeanne Connelly in her official capacity as treasurer ("Respondent") violated 52 U.S.C. 20 § 30104(b)(8) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d) by failing to report a debt. The Commission authorized 21 22 the Office of the General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Respondent and approved a conciliation agreement. 23 Attached is a conciliation agreement that has been signed by the Respondent. 24 25 26 27 Under these circumstances, we believe that the proposed conciliation agreement 28 represents an acceptable resolution of the matter. We therefore recommend that the Commission 29 30 accept the signed conciliation agreement with Brady PAC and Jeanne Connelly in her official capacity as treasurer and close the file in this matter. 31
